



DANBURY PARISH COUNCIL PUBLIC CONSULTATION

DAWSON MEMORIAL FIELD



The bank and path from the Mayes Lane car park to the Bowling Club and Tennis Club is suffering from severe slippage. This has caused the path to be unusable by the public and may have future consequences for the car park and bowling green (there is already a large crack under the car park side of the bank). The work required to resolve this issue will have a considerable cost implication on the Parish Council (potentially in the region of £100,000). As the Parish Council does not have the funds available to carry out this work, it will have to consider the following options. The Parish Council has

already paid £7,000 for consultancy work and monitoring on the bank. It will also have to pay for a specialist to write a specification for the work.

- Apply for grants
- Increase the precept in the financial year 2019 - 2020
- Obtain a Public Works Loan for part or the whole cost

At the present time, the total costs are unknown and no decision has been made. The Parish Council is investigating all avenues of funding. To obtain a Public Works Loan, the Parish Council must consult with Danbury residents. Comments are therefore invited from residents on the above proposal.
