### **Small Electrical Equipment Collections 'Sparks' Interest In Chelmsford**

Chelmsford City Council has launched a new innovative kerbside collection service for small WEEE (Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment).

Residents can place their small WEEE items out loose, either next to or on top of their green box, by 7am on their collection day. In Chelmsford, small WEEE is categorised as small handheld items that require a plug, or batteries to use, such as: hairdryers, radios, clothes irons, toasters and small power tools.

Larger WEEE items such as televisions, desktop computers, hoovers etc can be collected by the council (chargeable service). To arrange a collection please call 01245 615800. Alternatively, you can take your items to a Household Waste Recycling Centre. There are two in Chelmsford:
